Students aboard the Island Odyssey / Island Roamer

The nature of an adventure is traveling into the unknown and thereby learning about the world and oneself. We expect you to come prepared to learn, to undertake new activities and challenges and to try your best. This is an incredible opportunity.

Rules while on board - For the comfort and safety of all.

- No junk food – gum, soft drinks, potato chips, candy bars, peanuts etc... between meals there are always snacks provided.
 - The “Island Odyssey” and “Island Roamer” are beautiful yachts – abuse of the boats will not be tolerated. Any damage will be the responsibility of the person doing the damage and of the school.
 - As a school program, alcohol, cigarettes or illegal drugs are not allowed.
 - Please leave your cell phones, iPods, MP3 players, portable game devices and any other electronics at home.
 - Make up, hair blow-dryers or curling irons are unnecessary while on board. Electricity is not available in the cabins most of the time. Chargers for camera batteries are allowed.
 - Water needs to be conserved as we carry a limited amount of fresh water. There may or may not be showers available – salt water bathing is an alternative.
 - Life-jackets must be worn at all times in the small boats and at the discretion of the crew at other times.
 - Clean up after yourself, keep you cabin tidy, and carry out your responsibilities cheerfully.
 - There will be set time for lights out which must be respected.
 - Only those assigned to cabins should be in those cabins.
 - Be prepared to listen and follow instructions.
1. I agree to be attentive, ready to help, learn and participate fully in all the operations of the boat, from navigation to sailing to cleaning, dishes, and/or cooking. To help in any way necessary when asked by crew of the Island Odyssey, Island Roamer, teacher or adult supervisor.
 2. I have read and understood the “**RULES WHILE ON BOARD “ISLAND ODYSSEY”**” and “**ISLAND ROAMER”**” and agree that I will comply fully with all the rules.
 3. I understand that anything I bring to the boat that is not permitted (such as junk food or cigarettes) will be either left at the dock or disposed of at the discretion of the crew.
 4. If the crew of the vessels at any time feels that my actions or behaviour has impacted the trip in a negative way, I will be asked by the crew to leave the trip immediately.
